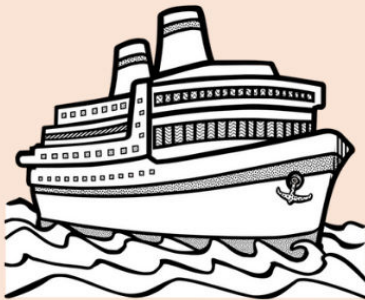
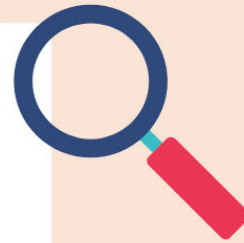

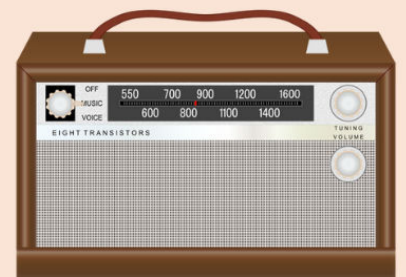
Use your internet sleuthing skills to find the answers to the following questions.

Who was the first person to prove you can transmit and receive electric waves wirelessly?



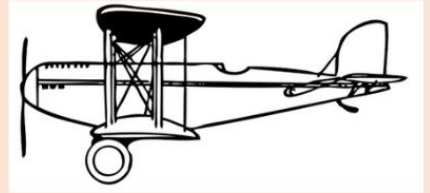
What invention is credited with saving 700 people from the Titanic?
